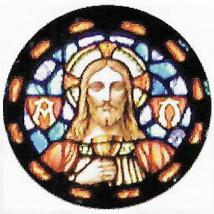

Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church Foundation is the realization of a dream that supports our church and its ministries for present and future generations!

Shortly after we came to PHUMC, Freddie and I met with our attorney for the purpose of updating our wills and including the church in our estate, as we have done for most of our ministry. Just as we tithe our present income to the church, our wills provide that ten-percent of our estate will benefit future ministries through the church endowment. This is a source of great joy to us.

Very soon afterward, an Endowment Committee was organized for the purpose of promoting planned giving in the church. The efforts of the committee, chaired by Keith Billingsley, began to bear fruit through estate and other planned gifts to the church endowment. I am very grateful to this early committee and our Board of Trustees for their commitment, vision and faith that led to the formation of PHUMC Foundation.

Lynn provides splendid leadership to the Foundation built on her love for Christ and the church, her relationship with members, and her enthusiasm for the mission of the Foundation.

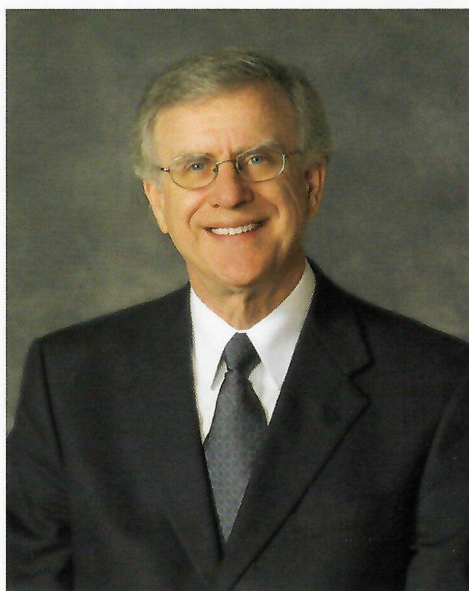

MESSAGE FROM 2005 CHAIRPERSON

On October 27, 2003, at the request of the Board of Trustees and the Endowment Committee, a charge conference at Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church created the PHUMC Foundation. Although October 27, 2003 was a historic date in the life of our church, the journey actually began in 1985 when the late Alton Raney made a gift of \$50,000 to Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church. The Board of Trustees, under the leadership of Maurice Mitchell, wisely decided not to simply add the \$50,000 to the 1985 church budget. Instead, the Board of Trustees used this initial gift to establish the PHUMC Endowment Fund. Since 1985, the principal value of gifts and bequests, like that provided by Alton Raney, have created many wonderful endowment funds benefiting Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church and the many ministries and services it provides. In just 22 short years, the Endowment Funds have grown from \$50,000 to over \$4 million. As with all endowment funds, the principal is never spent. The income is available to support the ministries of PHUMC.

Much like the congregational walk down Woodlawn Avenue that culminated in the building of our current sanctuary in 1950, the establishment of the PHUMC Foundation provides the framework for assisting members in making both lifetime gifts and bequests to benefit Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church for many years to come.

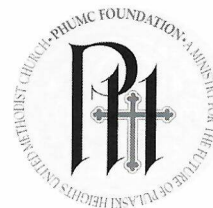

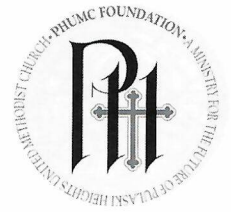
Anonymous Giver Donates \$25,000

Margaret Houston's Sons Establish Endowment

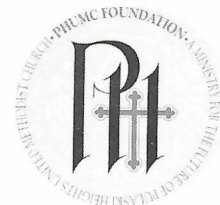

For mission that bids us turn prayer into deed."

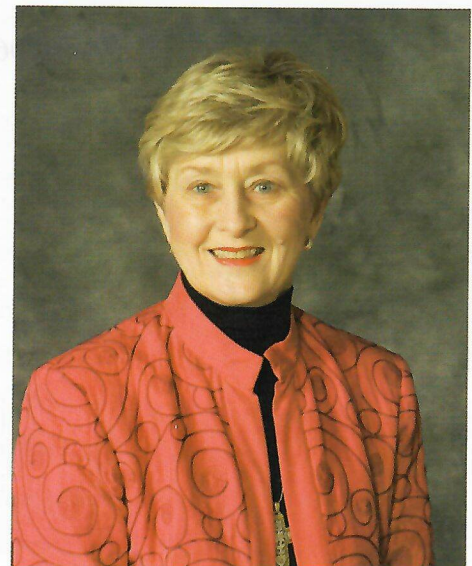

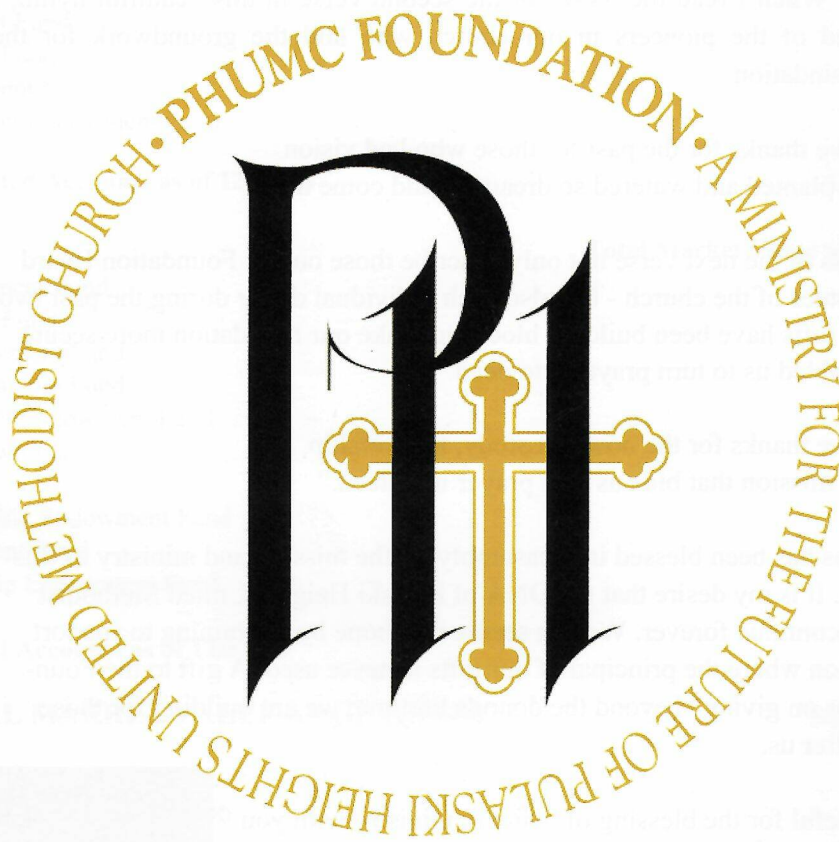
