

2008 HIGHLIGHTS

The Cecil and Betty Malone Older Adult Ministry Endowment was made possible by a gift of \$100,000 from the Malones, who have been actively involved in older adult ministries, including Helping Hands, Archives, Butler Upper Room Class, Primetimers, etc. Because of their love for PHUMC, this church can continue to minister to its beloved older members in the name of Jesus Christ.

"Planned Gifts Benefit All" was the topic of a luncheon seminar sponsored by the Foundation on June 18 featuring Jim Argue, Jr., Director of the United Methodist Foundation of Arkansas. Jim presented Information about "win-win" gifts for both donor and charity.


