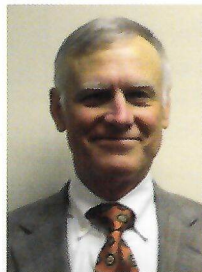

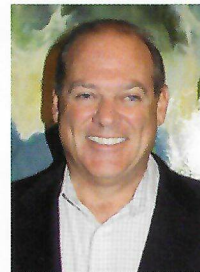

We have very exciting news! To celebrate our church's 100th birthday, the Foundation has established the Centennial Preservation Endowment. Its sole purpose is to guarantee



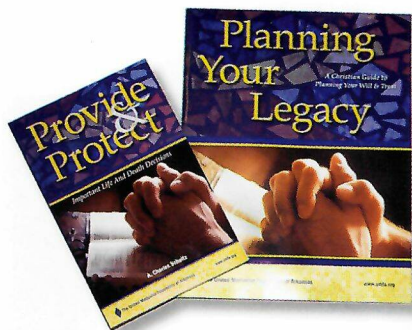

If the congregation raises \$500,000, a generous anonymous donor and the Foundation will each contribute \$250,000. 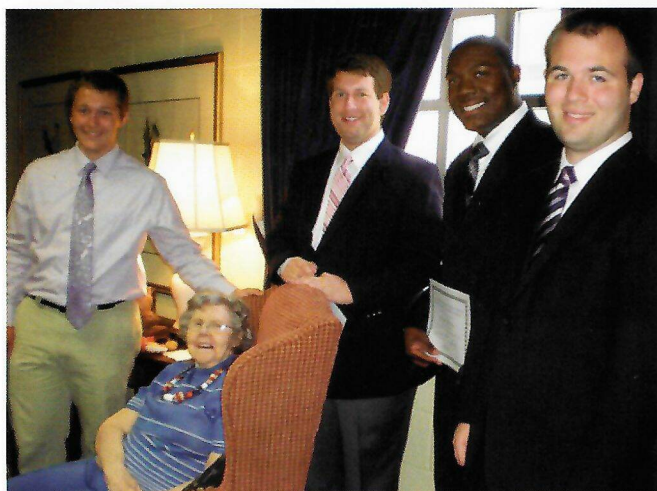

The presenters were Keith Billingsley, attorney, and Jim Argue, Executive Director of the United Methodist Foundation of Arkansas.



**The James M. and Mary A. Collins Worship Ministry Endowment** was established by generous donations from their sons, James M. Collins, Jr. and Dr. Charles M. Collins. Available income from the endowment will go toward enrichment of the Friday at 6 pm worship service, which meant a great deal to Jim and Mary. They were faithful worshippers at that service and were also active in the Primetimers ministry. Jim died on April 7, 2011 and Mary died on February 22, 2012.



**The John E. and Marjorie Dunn Gilleland Endowment** was established by generous contributions from John Gilleland in memory of his wife, Marge, who died on January 22, 2007, and in appreciation of Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church, their church home since 1961. John served as one of the head ushers for several decades and Marge was instrumental in the formation of the Altar Guild. They were both faithful members of the Upper Room Sunday School Class and were honorary members of the Board of Stewards.



**Recipients of Berry Scholarships.** Archer Tribbett, Christopher Dunn, Isaiah Bailey, and Tyler Adcock, recipients of Berry college scholarships for 2011-2012, were honored at a reception in June, along with Mrs. Arminta Berry, founder of the Stanley and Arminta Berry Music and Arts Scholarships. ### The H. Maurice and Betty Stockley Mitchell

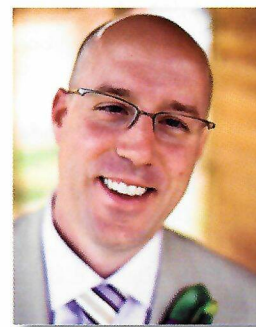
**Endowment** was announced on July 24. When Mr. Mitchell died on April 2, 2011, his family made plans for the endowment and requested that his memorials be designated toward the endowment named in memory of Maurice and in honor of Betty. Several months later, the Foundation received a significant gift from Mr. Mitchell's estate which was also placed in the endowment. Mr. Mitchell served on the Board of Trustees of PHUMC for three decades. He was also instrumental in the establishment of the PHUMC Foundation and served on that board as well. His wife, Betty, supported Maurice in his many church activities and was very active in the Children's Division. Betty died on July 25, 2011.



**The Brent Edward Coker Endowment** was established in loving memory of Brent by his family. Brent, the son of Daryl Coker and Candy Ramsey and brother of Brian Coker, grew up in the PHUMC church family. He was baptized in 1985, confirmed in 1997, and was active in ministries for children and youth. He died suddenly on June 16, 2010, at the age of twenty-five. The University of Arkansas posthumously awarded Brent a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree in May of 2011.



**The 2011 Willing Friends Luncheon** featured speaker on October 23 was Tyler Denton, a staff member of ONE, a non-profit organization co-founded in 2004 by U2 lead singer Bono. to that fair-haired youth may a pitfall be;

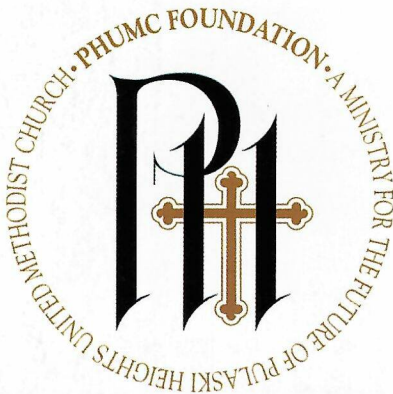
He, too, must cross in the twilight dim,
