## **TWELVE STONES SET UP AT GILGAL**

*Then Joshua summoned the twelve men from the Israelites, whom he had appointed, one from each tribe. Please accept our heartfelt thanks for your contributions to our church's Foundation and please continue to pray for its future.

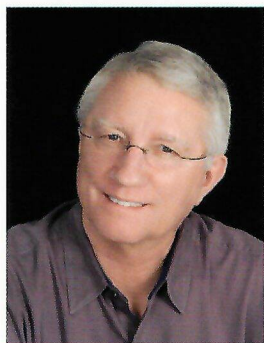

**PHUMC FOUNDATION ASSETS PASS \$6,000,000 MARK.** The Foundation Board proudly announced that for the first time, the total market value of our total assets reached \$6,000,000 in late 2012.

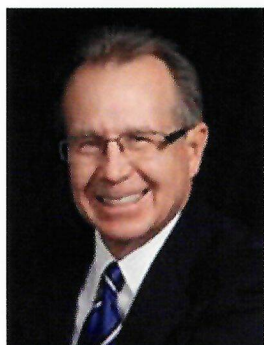
**CENTENNIAL PRESERVATION ENDOWMENT.** This endowment was established by the Foundation itself. Please read more about this exciting endowment – and match opportunity – on page 8.



**HAL BEARD STEPHEN MINISTRY ENDOWMENT.** Through a generous estate gift of \$50,000 from the late James H. Hal Beard, income from this endowment will provide resources for training and materials to new Stephen Ministers. Hal, who died suddenly in August of 2011, was a dedicated Stephen minister and Stephen Leader. He was often one of the first persons in Caring Ministry to reach out to others. Hal's wife, Alice, predeceased him. She also remembered the church in her will, leaving a bequest which funded the Alice Beard Altar Guild Endowment.



**DOT AND LOUIS EAST ENDOWMENT.** This endowment was established in honor of Dot and in memory of Louis by generous donations from their sons and families: Tom and Mary Carolyn East, Bob and Cynthia East. Dot and Louis provided leadership in many ministries for decades. Both were active members of the Upper Room Sunday School Class and Board of Stewards. The endowment is a part of the unrestricted endowment, which provides the Foundation's \$70,000 pledge each year to the church operating budget and grants to other ministries.



**BISHOP MUELLER ADDRESSED WILLING FRIENDS.** Bishop Gary E. Mueller, Episcopal leader for the Arkansas Area of the United Methodist Church, was the featured speaker at the annual Willing Friends Luncheon on December 4, 2012, in Wesley Hall. The Willing Friends Society is composed of over 200 PHUMC members who have made the decision to remember the church in their wills. The PHUMC Board honors this group at a luncheon or dinner annually.

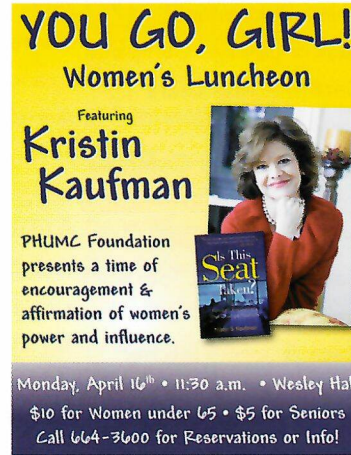

**JACK E. HILL TELEVISION MINISTRY ENDOWMENT.** Jack Hill, an active member of the Broadcast Ministry Board for many years, died on July 12, 2012. An endowment in his name was established by a generous gift from Anne Hill, as well as memorials given at his death. Income from the endowment will support Jack's passion, the television ministry of PHUMC. Jack was also very involved with prison ministry at PHUMC's sister church in Ekaterinburg, Russia, and produced several documentaries about this prison ministry.



**FOUNDATION SPONSORED "YOU GO, GIRL!"** A new undertaking in 2012 was a women's luncheon called, "You Go, Girl!" which offered encouragement and affirmation of women's power and influence. The featured speaker was Kristin Kaufman, author of the recently published book, *Is This Seat Taken?* Approximately 90 PHUMC members and guests were in attendance.



**THE ELIZABETH "BETTY" COPELAND MEYER LOCAL YOUTH MISSION ENDOWMENT** was established by a donation from her husband, Richard, and memorials given at her death in 2011. Income from the endowment will support youth mission trips in Arkansas, a passion of the Meyers. Betty was chair of the Board of Stewards and the Centennial Committee and was actively involved in leadership in the church throughout her life. Now youth people from PHUMC will be sent out in loving service to others in her name in perpetuity through this endowment.



**VEENA AKAMA-MAKIA RECEIVES A SCHOLARSHIP FROM THE BERRY ENDOWMENT.** Veena, graduating senior, received a \$1,000 scholarship to University of Central Arkansas in the fall of 2012. ## Accuracy of Records

From 1958 when the endowment fund was established, every effort has been made by church staff to keep accurate records and the PHUMC Foundation Board and staff have made a commitment to continue this practice. If we have made a mistake in this report, we sincerely apologize. Please let us know if there are any errors and we will see that they are corrected immediately.

## Centennial Preservation Endowment

With the desire to recognize the 100th birthday of the church, the PHUMC Foundation Board established the Centennial Preservation Endowment in 2011. Income from this endowment will go toward maintenance and preservation of our beautiful facilities. The church spends approximately \$200,000 annually for those purposes.

The goal of the Endowment is to raise \$1,000,000, thus providing approximately \$40,000 for maintenance and preservation in perpetuity. The Foundation Board has voted to give \$250,000 from the unrestricted endowment to the Centennial Preservation Endowment.

An anonymous donor will give \$250,000 if the congregation can raise \$500,000. At the time this report was printed, \$480,980.82 has been given/pledged. Donations are welcome so that we can meet our match and receive the \$250,000 and reach our goal of \$1,000,000. Even more important, this great church can continue to train and disciple children, youth, and adults to go into the world to make more disciples of Jesus Christ – “to love God and neighbor and change the world.”

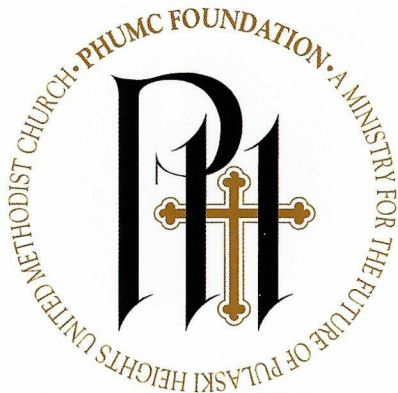
