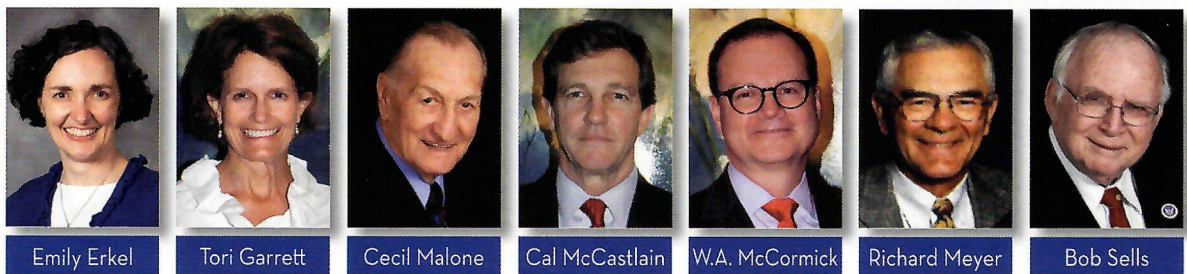

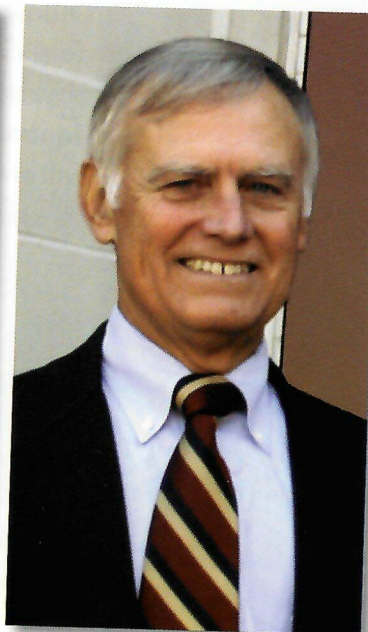

Dear PHUMC Family and Friends,

When we look back at 2013, the words of St. Paul in Philippians 1:3 come to mind: "I thank my God every time I remember you..." Paul was overcome with joy and thanksgiving because of the faith and love the Philippians had shared with him. Members of the PHUMC Foundation Board are also filled with joy and thanksgiving because of the faithful support of this congregation this past year... and every year since the Foundation's inception.



We are especially thankful this year for your support of the Centennial Preservation Endowment. Because of your donations to this endowment, we were able to meet our goal of raising \$500,000 from the congregation to match the anonymous gift of \$250,000 and the \$250,000 gift from the Foundation's unrestricted funds. **These gifts gave the Foundation its first million dollar endowment.** Income from the Centennial Endowment will be approximately \$40,000 annually in perpetuity, which will be applied toward maintenance and preservation of our beautiful facilities. With this significant relief to the operating budget, more money can be spent on mission and ministry. Your gifts have made this dream become a reality. The Foundation Board and church staff truly do "thank God every time we remember you."

In closing, we ask for your prayers as our Foundation continues to lay a strong foundation for our beloved church so that disciples may be sent out to love God and neighbor and change the world.

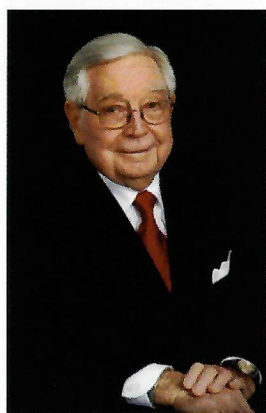
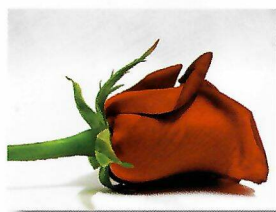
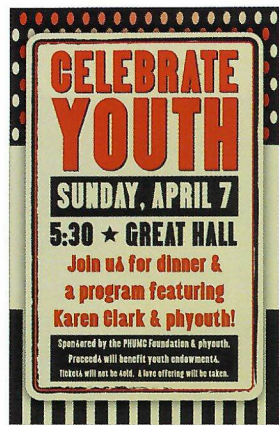

**CELEBRATE YOUTH**, a benefit for the three youth endowments, had its debut on Sunday, April 7, and featured Karen Clark and phyouth in a delightful musical program after a delicious spaghetti supper. The entertainers received a standing ovation from those in attendance. It was so popular that an encore performance was offered a month later on Mother’s Day afternoon. A total of \$8,650.88 was raised in these two settings through love offerings to benefit youth endowments.

**HONORING AND REMEMBERING MOTHERS AND GRANDMOTHERS** was sponsored again by the Foundation in 2013. For a \$10 contribution to the Foundation, members received a beautiful red or white rose to present to mothers and grandmothers and a Bible bookmark for fathers and grandfathers. In addition, the Foundation sent the person or family being honored a letter to tell them about the donation. This effort netted \$2,180 for the Foundation operating fund.

**PHUMC FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES ESTATE GIFT FROM JOHN GILLELAND.** In earlier years John Gilleland made gifts of approximately \$10,000 to establish the *John and Marjorie Gilleland Endowment*. After Marge’s death in 2007 and John’s death in 2013, the church received notification that John had designated the Foundation as beneficiary of one of his insurance policies and \$5,380 was added to the Gilleland Endowment. Marge and John joined the church in 1961 and were faithful members of the church and the Upper Room Class. Marge actively participated in the Altar Guild and John served as head usher for many years.

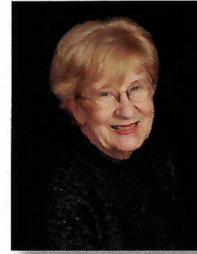

The endowment was established in 2006 by generous donations totaling \$100,000 from Mrs. Berry, who made this statement at the time of her

first donation: “This church has meant a great deal to our family for almost 50 years. Because of all it has done for the Berry family, I want to make a contribution to its future so that its ministries will continue to help others.”

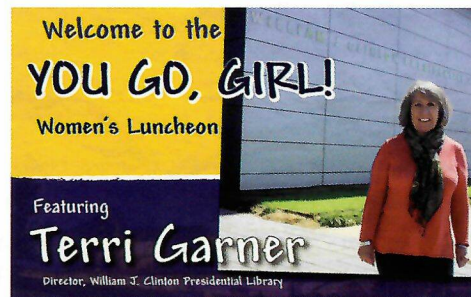
## FOUNDATION RECEIVES GIFT FROM THE ESTATE OF JANICE YEATMAN IN JULY.

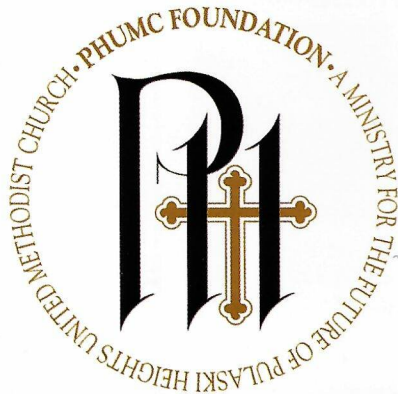
