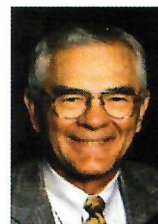

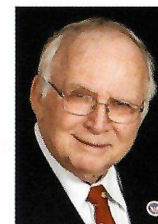

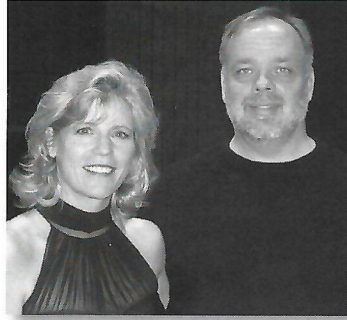

BECOME A WILLING FRIEND was the PHUMC Foundation's emphasis in January, the perfect time to get one's house in order. Studies show that 50% of Americans do not have a will and the Foundation challenged members to: (1) Execute a will and (2) Consider remembering the church in those wills. Income from testamentary gifts helps to ensure our beloved church's future.



DIVAS AND DESSERTS One of the favorite events at PHUMC was back this year in "Cabaret of Love Songs" on February 9th with Mary Ann Robinson and James Maase as stars. A "love offering" of approximately \$2,470 was taken to benefit the Louis L. Sanders Music Endowment.

THE BETTY GLASSCOCK LANDSCAPE MINISTRY ENDOWMENT

was established by the Glasscock family and friends in memory of the late Betty Glasscock, who died on February 10, 2014. Betty was a faithful member of



the church for 55 years, serving in many ministries. She had a passion for gardening and also had attained the distinction of master gardener. She worked diligently on the landscaping in front of the sanctuary and on other beds around the church grounds. Income from this endowment will be available in perpetuity to enhance landscaping of the church grounds.



THE KEARNEY AND FLOY JEAN DIETZ MEMORIAL CHILDREN'S ENDOWMENT

was established by gifts from the Dietz family and friends in memory of Floy Jean, who died on March 28, 2014, and in honor of Kearney. Income from the endowment will be used to enrich the Children's Ministry at PHUMC. Floy Jean taught a preschool class for decades and was always an active supporter of the Children's Ministry. She and Kearney joined PHUMC in 1954 and have been faithful members since that time, serving the church in

a wide variety of ways. Kearney said, "I felt that an endowment which provides support for children's ministry forever would be a wonderful way for her to be remembered."



STANLEY AND ARMINTA BERRY MUSIC AND ARTS SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS WERE HONORED

at a reception on June 8. Parker Pitts, who will attend the University of Arkansas at Little Rock majoring in art, was chosen as the freshman recipient. Recipients for the past school year were Isaiah Bailey, Veena Akama-Makia, Archer Tribett, and Kyle Forehand. Isaiah Bailey graduated from Oklahoma City University in May

with a major in vocal performance. Parker and the other three students will receive scholarships of \$1,000 each for the next school year.

THE PHUMC FOUNDATION ANNOUNCED COMPLETION OF ITS GOAL OF \$500,000 FOR CENTENNIAL PRESERVATION ENDOWMENT.

In recognition of the 100th birthday of PHUMC, the Foundation Board established an endowment which would provide income for the maintenance and preservation of our beautiful buildings. An anonymous donor promised \$250,000 if the congregation raised \$500,000, which was reached in 2014. With \$250,000 from unrestricted funds in the Foundation, this gave the Foundation its first million dollar endowment.

FOUNDATION APPROVES A \$4,200 GRANT IN AVAILABLE INCOME in the CLC Endowment for purchase of furniture and equipment for a new infant room. With the addition of a new classroom, this wonderful PHUMC ministry is able to provide childcare for 12 new families. The following were purchased: 9 additional cribs, 2 exersaucers, 9 high chairs, a microwave, play mats, toys and supplies.

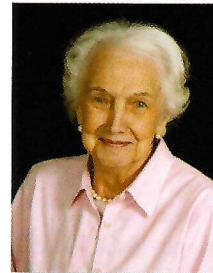
THE FOUNDATION APPROVED A GRANT FOR \$17,541.95 FROM AVAILABLE INCOME IN THE CENTENNIAL ENDOWMENT for repairs on HVAC systems, sprinkler system repairs, and a new fire panel in the main building. Appreciation is expressed once again to George and Bess Campbell, the first donors to the endowment ... to the anonymous donor of a \$250,000 matching gift ... and to all of the other donors to the Centennial Endowment.

THE CALLAWAY/TIMMONS PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY ENDOWMENT was established by a generous gift from Paula Watson in loving memory of her mother, Sarah Smith Callaway Timmons, who died September 2, 2012. Income from this endowment will be used to provide yarn, needles, and other materials for the prayer shawl ministry. When Mrs. Timmons was ill in West Virginia, a prayer shawl from our church was sent to her and she used it every day after receiving it. Mrs. Watson said, "I wanted to do my part to make sure that this ministry continues." Paula has served the church in many ways, including Mission Board, Board of Stewards, and working on special projects such as the Salvation Army Christmas Bell Ringing.

FOUNDATION EXPRESSES APPRECIATION FOR ESTATE GIFT. The Foundation received a generous bequest of \$5,000 from the estate of the late Anna Thomas, who died on September 5, 2014. Anna was an active member of PHUMC for two extended periods of her life - before and after her service in the senatorial office of Senator David Pryor. She served in many ministries, including the Sanctuary and Energizer Choirs, Primetimers, and Helping Hands Respite Care.

THE JOSEPHINE LEWIS RENSHAW ENDOWMENT WAS ESTABLISHED BY A GENEROUS ESTATE GIFT OF \$242,140 from Mrs. Renshaw's will. Jo was a dedicated member of PHUMC for many years. She faithfully attended the Friday worship service and supported PHUMC Mission Ministries, especially the Good Samaritan Fund. She was also an "office angel" who recorded worship attendance every week for all five worship services. When Jo told the Foundation director, Rev. Lynn Lindsey, about her estate plans, she expressed deep love for the church and her desire to make a lasting gift, one that would help build a stronger church for the future.



KATYE DUNN RECEIVED A COKENOUR SCHOLARSHIP. Church member and former associate youth director, Katye Dunn, received a \$1,000 scholarship from the Cokenour Endowment. Katye is pursuing a Master of Divinity degree at Garrett Theological Seminary, Northwestern University, Chicago, Illinois. The Cokenour Endowment was established to provide scholarships to those who are pursuing church-related professions.

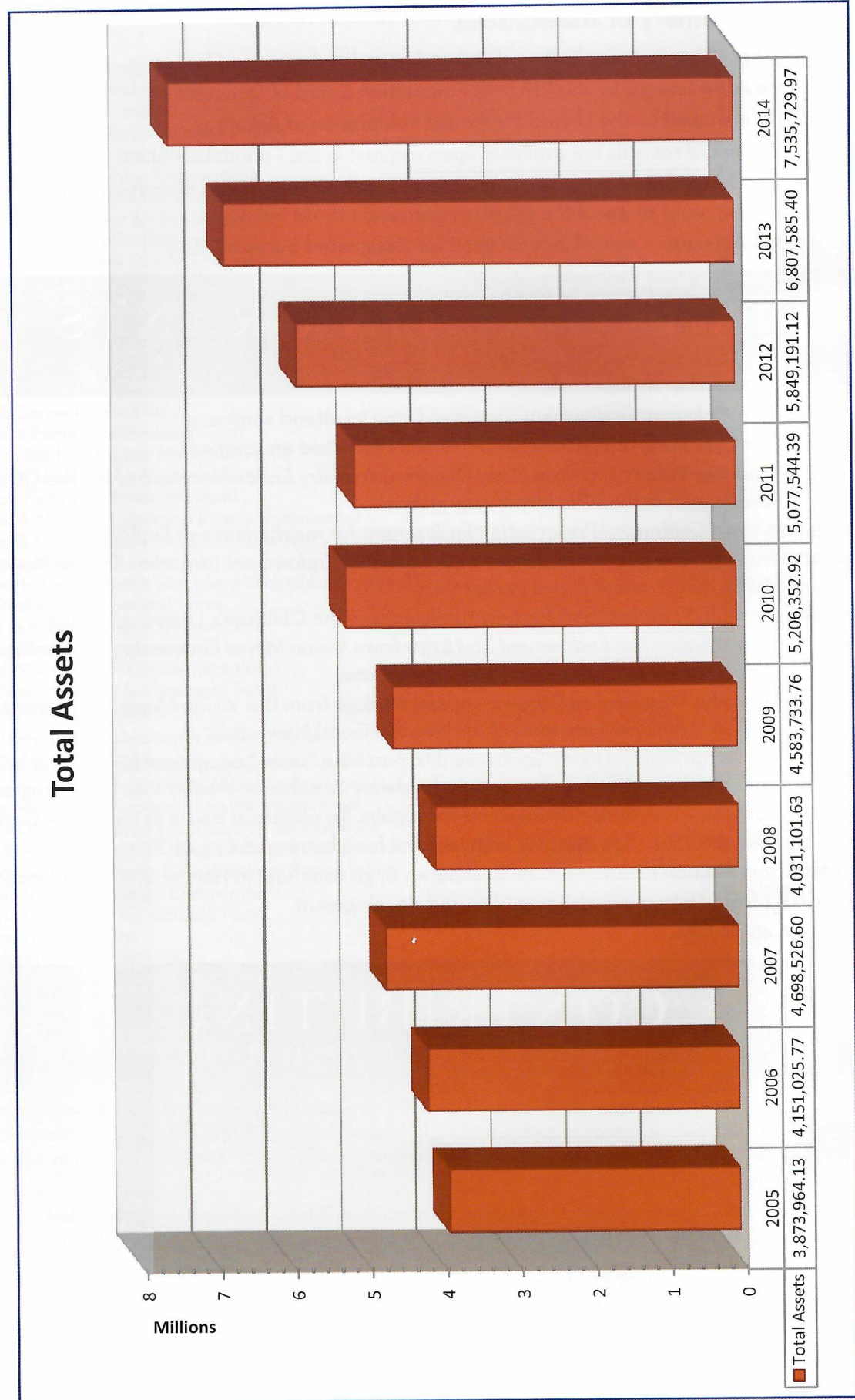

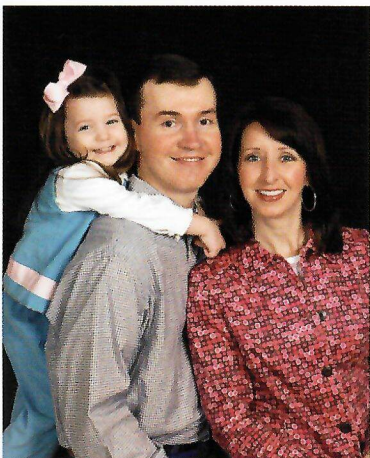

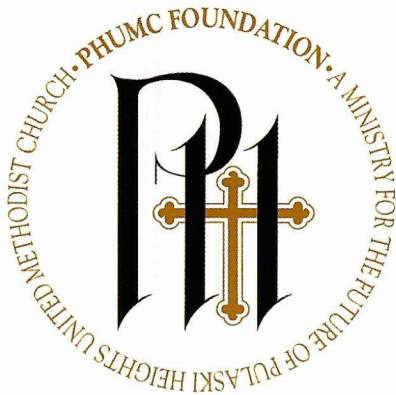


ANDI AND CAREY SMITH:
