



PHUMC Foundation ... Ministry Now and Forever

When the Foundation was incorporated in 2003, its founders adopted this mission statement: "PHUMC Foundation...a ministry for the future of Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church." Ministry for the future is indeed a wonderful description of the Foundation's purpose.

However, it is important to realize that the Foundation also impacts ministry in the present – right now! We often describe it as "Ministry Now and Forever". As a matter of fact, the PHUMC Foundation was the largest contributor to the operating budget of the church in 2015. In its 11 year history, the Foundation has contributed over \$1,000,000 to the church through annual pledges and grants from endowments – "now ministry".



We had an outstanding year in 2015, resulting in contributions of \$181,065 to the church. I invite you to read through this annual report, paying special note to the following two sections:

Appreciation is expressed to the late Don Morey and his wife, Dorothy Morey, for their generosity in designating the Foundation as beneficiary on two of Don's life insurance policies. Don was active with the Board of Stewards, Dietz Dialogue Class, and Helping Hands. The family requested that Don's estate gifts totaling \$7,401.43 be directed to the Cokenour Endowment with the PHUMC Foundation. Income from this endowment is used for

scholarships for those planning to enter a church-related profession.



Back by Popular Demand, Foundation Sponsors "You Go, Girl"! Kristin Kaufman, author and consultant, spoke at the third "You Go, Girl!" event on Monday, May 4. These events are sponsored by the Foundation to affirm the influence women have in their homes, workplaces, churches and communities in the areas of philanthropy, stewardship, and leadership.





Foundation Sponsors Second CELEBRATE YOUTH! on May 31.

Grace Jackson, Karen Clark, and phyouth were featured in a performance in the sanctuary, following a dinner in the Great Hall. Proceeds were divided between the three youth endowments, which were all established to enrich youth ministry at PHUMC.



Four PHUMC Youth Were Awarded Berry Scholarship at Reception on May 31. Shelby Taylor and Caitlon Tribett were new recipients of the Stanley and Arminta Berry Music and Arts Scholarships for the 2015-2016 school year. Scholarships for Kyle Forehand and Veena Akama-Makia were renewed for another year. The Berry Music and Arts Scholarship Endowment was established in 2006 to provide scholarships for qualified students planning to major in music or one of the arts. A total of 27 scholarships have been awarded since 2006.



Katye Dunn Awarded Scholarship for Last Year in Seminary. Church member and former associate youth director, Katye Dunn, received a \$1,000 scholarship from the Cokenour Endowment for her last year of seminary at Garrett Theological Seminary, Northwestern University, Chicago, Illinois. Katye is pursuing a Master of Divinity degree and will graduate in the spring of 2016.

Foundation Approves \$22,644.87 Request from Trustees. A grant from the Centennial Preservation Endowment was used to replace the boiler in the Nixon Disciple Center. The Centennial Endowment of \$1,000,000 was established in 2014 by \$250,000 grants from the Foundation and an anonymous donor – and \$500,000 match in congregational donations.

Mack McLarty and Skip Rutherford featured at Willing Friends Appreciation Luncheon. A very receptive audience of approximately 300 PHUMC Willing Friends and guests were treated to a delightful presentation on August 16 called Swapping Stories about Arkansas, the USA, and the World. "Tales of the South" taped the event and broadcast it at a later date.

Jim Argue, Jr. Presents Workshop. "Turn Your Generosity Into Lifetime Income" was sponsored by the Foundation on October 26 by Jim Argue, Director of United Methodist Foundation of Arkansas. Participants learned how to receive guaranteed payments for life through charitable gift annuities.

Donations in Memory of Betty Brown. Appreciation is expressed for the generous donations of \$100,000 each, which were made in December by Stephanie Kyser and Lee Brown in loving memory of their mother, Betty Brown, who died on August 25, 2015. A named endowment will be established early in 2016. Betty was a faithful member of PHUMC for forty-three years. She also made generous donations toward furnishings for the Nixon Disciple Center, including the beautiful mobile which hangs in the stairwell.

Friends of Jack Fryer Establish Endowment. Many devoted friends and family members of Jack Fryer made donations to the Jack Fryer Music Ministry Endowment in loving memory after his death on May 27, 2015. Income from the endowment will be used to enrich the PHUMC Music Ministry which was beloved by Jack. He served in the Sanctuary Choir of the church for over thirty years. In addition, he was active in Men Alive and other mission and education ministries.




Landmark Decisions by 2015 Foundation Board. The Board made the following significant

decisions which will impact present and future ministry in the PHUMC congregation:
Increase of annual pledge to the church operating budget from \$70,000 to \$80,000.

- Grants of \$20,000 from Foundation Operating Budget to new church ministries \$10,000 each for 2015 and 2016. These grants will be announced early in 2016. The Board hopes to make special grants for exciting ministries on an annual basis.
- Collaboration with the Clinton School of Public Service in sponsoring presentations in April by Rev. Becca Stevens, noted Episcopalian priest in Nashville, Tennessee and founder of Magdalene Ministries. Rev. Stevens will speak at the Clinton School on April 1 at 6 p.m. and at PHUMC on April 2. In addition she will preach in morning worship services on April 3.

Dorothy Stout Aldridge Endowment. This endowment was established with a generous gift from Dorothy Aldridge in memory of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Carl Stout. They were devoted members of PHUMC and supported it in many ways, including the donation of the organ, which is used in the Shamblin Chapel. Dorothy is also a faithful PHUMC member, serving in Stephen Ministry, Caring Ministry hospital visitation, the Mary and Martha UMW group, as one of the chairs of the Intercessory Prayer Group, and serves on the Foundation Board.

The following information was presented to the Board of Stewards on January 25, 2016 by Rev. Lynn Lindsey, Executive Director of the PHUMC Foundation:

- The total assets of the Foundation have grown from \$3,645,874.65 in 2004 to \$7,113,341.79. (despite a recession and an economic downturn)
- Since the Foundation's inception, it has contributed over \$1,000,000 to the church operating budget through annual pledges and grants from restricted endowments.
- Over 240 church members have made the decision to remember the church in their wills, thus joining the *Willing Friends Society*.
- Forty-six new endowments have been established, enriching many ministries.
- The Centennial Preservation Endowment, the first \$1,000,000 endowment, was established in 2014 with income to be used for maintenance and preservation of facilities.
- In 2015, the Foundation Board authorized \$20,000 in grants from the Foundation Operating budget for special ministries.
- The Board also approved increasing the Foundation's annual pledge of \$70,000 to \$80,000 to the PHUMC Operating Budget, beginning in 2016.
- The Foundation has sponsored eleven seminars to educate the congregation about planned giving, personal finance decisions, and end of life decisions.
- Five Divas and Desserts concerts were offered to the church family which provided fellowship and wonderful music and also benefited the music ministry.
- Outstanding appreciation events were planned for Willing Friends, including presentations by Senator David Pryor, Mack McLarty, Skip Rutherford, Lawrence Hamilton, Mary Smith, and others.
- Three You Go, Girl! Luncheons and events were offered to PHUMC women and the community to affirm the significant role of women in philanthropy and leadership.
- Two Celebrate Youth events were sponsored to benefit youth ministry.
- Over 30 college and seminary scholarships have been granted to deserving youth from the Berry and Cokenour Scholarship endowments.
- Many generous estate gifts were gratefully received and acknowledged from faithful church members.


